“THE PARALYMPIC” GOLD STAMPS ARE THE REAL WINNERS!

The only G.B. Commemorative ever to be on sale for less than 5 MONTHS (all officially withdrawn from sale on the 31st December 2012) – they were NOT included in the Royal Mail Annual Year Packs or Year Books!

Stanley Gibbons have assigned a separate catalogue number for all the single stamps and an “a” number for the sheetlets of 6 (Olympic) and sheetlets of 2 (Paralympics).

The Paralympics set of 34 was not received very well at the time, and now collectors are deciding that they should have them. Royal Mail have confirmed that there will be no reprint!

2012 OLYMPIC GOLD MEDAL WINNERS GENERIC DESIGN ‘NELSON PRINT’ VALUE ‘NUMBER 30 OF THE SERIES’



An unissued generic design identical to the format of the actual issued stamps and printed in A4 sheets which have four sheetlets of six stamps. They are similar to the trial dummy stamp which was prepared for pre-publicity but these are fully perforated on phosphor paper, self-adhesive with the Queen’s head and NV1 1st value which was produced by ‘Nelson’ a firm of printers in Lancashire which was not chosen as one of the six printers used to print the gold medal winners stamps. They were apparently printed in May of 2012 and a small number of sheets have now come onto the market, also some used stamps have turned up in kiloware, as they were mainly sold as discount Postage!
