

# SOMALILAND MACHIN PROVISIONAL OVERPRINT

In 1992, Somaliland decided to leave the union and fully re-establish its independence in 1995. During 1996, the Government decided to re-establish a postal system. Due to a paper shortage of the type required, it was decided that an emergency issue should be made until arrival of the definitives from the US. After extensive searching, no printer in Africa could be found to undertake the work at such short notice. As the urgency of some stamps became acute, it was decided to release a 500 Shillin value. This was overprinted on a 1p GB Machin.
