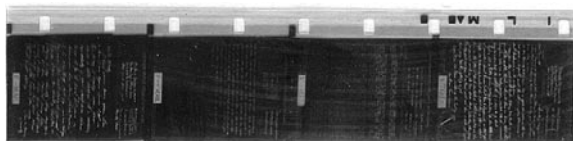


## ORIGINAL MICROFILM WORLD WAR II 'V' FOR VICTORY

## G.B. WARTIME 2½d GEORGE VI AUSTERITY PRINT IN LIGHT ULTRAMARINE

SG 489 (Cat. £0.30)

Issued during the War in July 1941. The 2½d was the standard letter rate and the most popular value replacing the Darker Ultramarine original stamp issued in 1937. A large quantity was found in a house clearance many years ago.
